Dato' Dr Lee is currently a practicing Consultant Orthopedic Surgeon and Head of Department of Orthopedic Surgery at Beacon International Specialist Centre and Advanced Neuroscience & Orthopedic Centre (ANOC) in Malaysia. He has been a member of **ISCD** for past twenty years and a Certified Clinical Densitometrist. He is currently the **Vice President and Board Member of ISCD**. Dato' Dr Lee was also the Co-author of the Consensus of Official Position of IOF/ISCD FRAX Initiatives in Asia Pacific region and Co-author of the Best Practices for Dual-Energy X-ray Absorptiometry, Measurement and Reporting: International Society for Clinical Densitometry Guidance.

Dato' Dr Lee was the Course Director of the **International Osteoporosis Foundation (IOF)-Malaysian Osteoporosis Society (MOS) Densitometry Course** for the year 2007 and 2009 and **International Society for Clinical Densitometry (ISCD)-Malaysian Osteoporosis Society (MOS) Densitometry Course** in 2011. He was the Chief Coordinator for the **International Society for Clinical Densitometry-Malaysian Society for Radiographers (ISCD-MSR) Osteoporosis Essential Course and Advanced Densitometry Courses** in October 2017 in Kuala Lumpur. He was the Co Course Director as well as speaker of the **IOF-ISCD Osteoporosis Essential (OE) Course** during the 6th IOF Asia Pacific Regional Meeting in Singapore in 2016.

Dato' Dr Lee is the current **Chair of the Asia Pacific-South Africa Regional Advisory Council (RAC) of International Osteoporosis Foundation (IOF)**. He was the Author of **IOF Asian Audit** (Malaysian Chapter) 2009 and **Asia Pacific Audit** (Malaysian Chapter) 2013. He is the **Coordinator of the International Osteoporosis Foundation-International Society for Clinical Densitometry-Asian Federation of Osteoporosis Societies (IOF-ISCD-AFOS) Tripartite Alliance**. He is the **Chief Coordinator** for the International Osteoporosis Foundation-Asia Pacific Orthopedics Association (**IOF-APOA Orthopedics Initiative**). Dato' Dr Lee was the Founding member of the **Asian Federation of Osteoporosis Society (AFOS)**.

Dato' Dr Lee is the **Co-Chair of the Asia Pacific Fragility Fracture Alliance (APFFA)**, an alliance formed by four Asia Pacific regional organizations (AFOS, APOA, APGMN, AOSPRM) and three international organizations (IOF, ISCD, FFN). He is also the **Vice President of Fragility Fracture Network of Malaysia (FFNM)**.

Dato' Dr Lee is the Past President and current Council Member of the **Malaysian Osteoporosis Society (MOS – Doctor Society)** and of the **Osteoporosis Awareness Society of Kuala Lumpur & Selangor (OASKLS - Public Society)**, member of the MOS Clinical Practice Guideline (2001, 2006, 2013 and Revised Edition of 2015), the Chief Coordinator for “Hip Fracture Incidence Study” in Malaysia for the year 1996/1997, the Chief Coordinator for “**Healthy Bone for Life Campaign**” for public in Malaysia from 2009 to 2017 and the Author for the “**Healthy Bone for Life Family Guidebook**” in three different languages.

Dato' Dr Lee is an active advocate and trainer for Fracture Liaison Service in Asia Pacific region. He is the Chief Coordinator and Leader for **Fracture Liaison Service (FLS)** in Beacon International Specialist Centre in Malaysia and this FLS Service had won one of the “Best Branding Award” judged by the Ministry of Health of Malaysia for 2017. He is a member of the Steering Committee of **Asia Pacific Bone Academy**, a program initiated by Amgen.
